Recommendations from Day 1

- Ensure to avoid any replications or overlap with other similar initiatives by other international organizations, by following the demand from member States.
- Collaborate with other organizations having diverse experiences in the field and keep reflecting the diversity of needs and practices in the region.
- Clearly define the work of ANTAM in relation to Codes, Standards, Certification.
- Do not place ANTAM as an alternative for national systems/stnadards, but as a system to harmonize them.
- Establish a network of test laboratories whose reports are accepted across participating members.
- Identify the most appropriate instrument to implement a mutual recognition system.
