Tractor Codes Funding

Programme Funds

- Secretariat staff and non-staff costs (meetings, missions, documents, etc)
- Public funding by participating countries



Co-ordinating Centre Funds

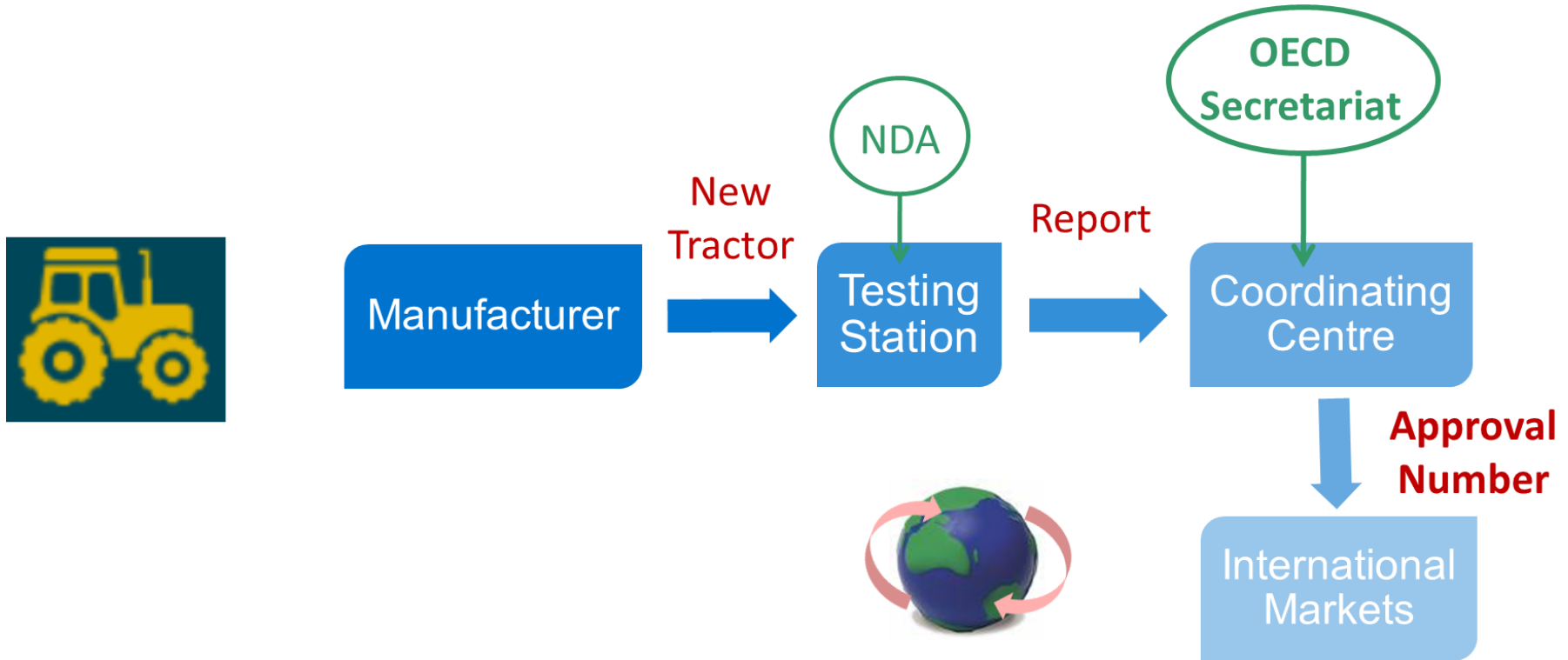
- Costs of the activities of the Co-ordinating Centre (staff costs, advice, travel, etc)
- Mixed: Private and public funding

Example Scales of Contribution

- The Programme is funded by participating countries - Public Sector funds.
- Biennial Budget
- Fees agreed and approved by Member Countries

Co-ordinating Centre Funding

- Mixed – Private and Public Sector Funds
- Tractor Manufacturers pay OECD a fee in order to obtain an OECD Approval Number.
- Fee is variable and depends on the Code and type of tests
- **Non-Profit organization.** Charges are the minimum to ensure the activities of the Co-ordinating Centre.
- 95% of the funds are used to pay the activities of the Co-ordinating Centre.
- The remaining 5% is allocated to fund research projects agreed **by consensus** by member countries.
